





Cold Wax with Oil Paint Schedule

This one-day workshop at Pazan Gallery will introduce participants to the development of textured paintings using cold wax with oil paints. Participants will explore the different techniques that are possible with this contemporary method of painting and learn to create rich, layered surfaces that are full of texture and depth. The workshop is NOT suitable for acrylic or watercolour painters or persons sensitive to solvent-based or traditional oil base paint.

- Discussion of how to create texture and depth

Please note that this course will involve working with solvents and oil paints, which can cause irritation to those who are sensitive. Students will attend at their own risk.

The course will be led by a professional oil painter who will provide hands-on guidance and support throughout the duration of the course. The overall atmosphere will be positive and friendly, with an emphasis on learning by doing. Additionally, students will be encouraged to bring their own images to work from during the course. However, it is important to keep in mind that the use of solvents and oil paints can be potentially hazardous, and students should take appropriate precautions to ensure their safety while working in the classroom.
